

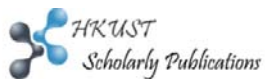



- Supports automated linkages between researcher & professional activities





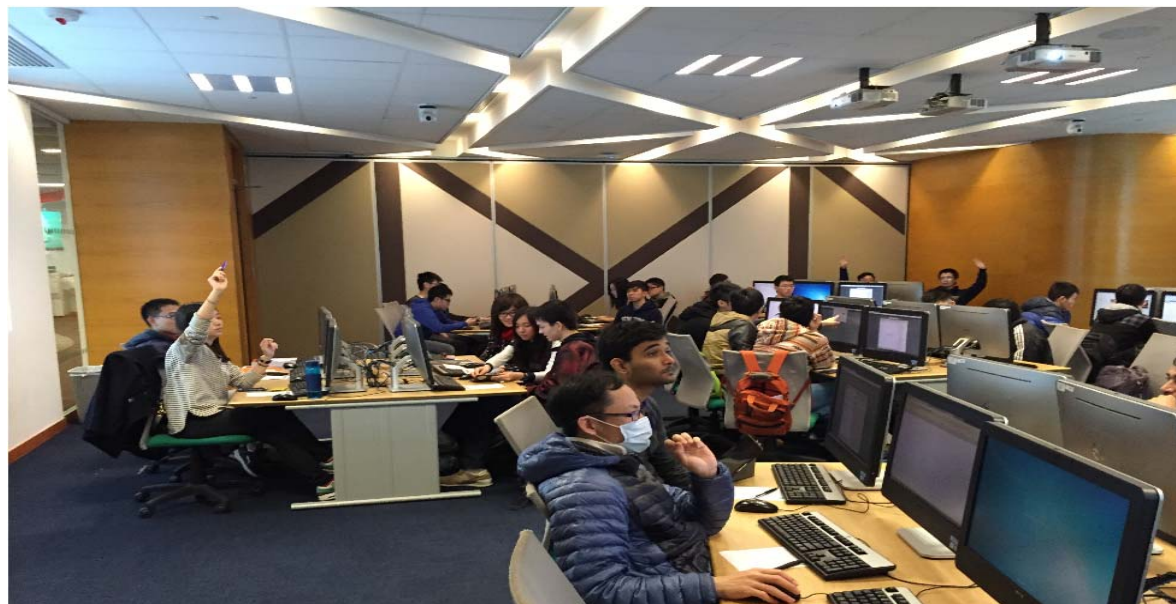


Eunice Wong (lbeunice@ust.hk / 2358-6751)

Thesis Submission:

The Library collects all HKUST theses and dissertations in both print and electronic format. You are required to submit a PDF copy of the approved version of your theses. The electronic version must be an exact copy of the print version. The PDF copy will be loaded into the [HKUST Electronic Theses](#) database and the [HKUST Institutional Repository](#). Doctoral dissertation will also be submitted for indexing and publishing to the [ProQuest Dissertations and Theses](#) database.
