

RPGs should seek endorsement from supervisor for use



- Helps establish priority of ideas and intellectual property (IP)



Good Reasons Why

- Highlights & promotes HKUST's research
- Shows impact via bibliometrics (citation counts)



145 documents are found in Scopus. They are cited 6512 times by documents in Scopus. The h-index is 48.

HKUST's ORCID integration:


- Helps faculty members to upload their publications from the SPD to ORCID

Document Delivery for PGs, faculty & staff

- Quota 60 requests per year
- No fee
- Request via Illiad system



Thesis Subsidy Scheme for RPGs (overseas theses)

- Quota- 3 theses per RPG per academic year
- Flat fee is HK\$30 for each thesis.
- Request via Illiad system

Thesis Submission:

The Library collects all HKUST theses and dissertations in both print and electronic format. You are required to submit a PDF copy of the approved version of your theses. The electronic version must be an exact copy of the print version. The PDF copy will be loaded into the HKUST Electronic Theses database and the HKUST Institutional Repository. Doctoral dissertation will also be submitted for indexing and publishing to the ProQuest Dissertations and Theses database.

Be sure to follow the HKUST Guidelines on Thesis Preparation.
